If your child had medication of any kind in the Health Office during the 2022-23 school year (epipen, inhalers, ADHD meds, Tylenol/ Advil, creams etc.), please plan to pick up your medications on or before the last day of school on **June 8th**. Please note that emergency medications such as epi pens and inhalers should remain at school until the last day of school. Over-the-counter medications can be sent home with your students, if you provide written permission via email to the Health Office (DHE.HealthOffice@minnetonkaschools.org). If you are unsure whether you have medication(s) at school, please call the Health Office. All medication must be picked up since we are unable to hold any items over the summer, per district policy. Any medication remaining in the Heath Office after June 8th will be discarded. Thanks for your cooperation!
