### **Grade level plans for school between now and February 1:**

#### **K-2**

E-Learning with the Childcare model ends this Friday, January 15.

Hybrid model at Deephaven Elementary from January 19-27.

In-person learning at Deephaven Elementary starts on February 1.

#### **Grade 3**

E-Learning with Childcare model at Deephaven Elementary continues through January 27.

In-person learning at Deephaven Elementary starts on February 1.

#### **Grades 4-5**

E-Learning with Childcare model ends this Friday, January 15.

Hybrid model at Minnetonka High School from January 19-22 (INCLUDING WEDNESDAY)

E-Learning with Childcare model at Deephaven Elementary on January 26 and 27.

In-person learning at Deephaven Elementary starts on February 1.

**No School on January 28 and 29** – Transition days for teachers.

**January 28 and 29 Childcare** – Childcare for students currently in our Childcare option will take place on the transition days of January 28 and 29. These are non-school days. The regular Childcare para will be supervising students and activities will be provided throughout the day for the students.

**Class Lists** for in-person learning will be sent out at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, January 22. Class lists will be in final form, and in most cases, students will continue to have the same classroom teacher. Please do not request a change in class placement, as it impacts students in the two classrooms involved, along with class sizes.

**Additional Class Placement Information** - Pods of no more than 15-17 students were created in August to adhere to the social distancing guidelines of 6 feet. Classes will return to their normal class size and social distancing between students will be reduced to 3 feet.

**School Map** – We will have all K-5 classrooms back at Deephaven on February 1, and a new map of our school will be sent out on Friday, February 22, along with class lists.

**Busing Plan** once we are back to in-person learning beginning February 1:

1. There will be no bus passes available for students other than their assigned bus.
2. The district and First Student will continue with seat assignments for contact tracing purposes. Students will continue to be added to the busing list if parents make the request to the transportation department, and if seating is available. Therefore, the seat assignments will take a while to create and will not be set for the first couple of weeks.
3. Bus numbers and routes are being worked on and will be communicated to parents once they are done.

**Dream Makers Dress Up and PJ Day** is Friday, January 22. Students are asked to bring a donation of \$1.00 - \$5.00 for the Minnetonka Foundation on Dress Up/PJ Day. Donations will be collected by the teachers. E-learners who choose to donate can either drop them off at Deephaven (there will be a drop box by the door) or send them via Venmo to @Paula\_Madel. The money collected will go directly towards the Fund-A Dream campaign, which is used to fund teacher grants throughout the district. If your child will be wearing a Halloween-type costume, please remember our policy of no toy weapons of any kind, and no masks (besides their Covid masks) that would prevent us from recognizing your child. **A donation is not required for students to participate in Dress Up/PJ Day.
