The remaining courses must be studied at the standard level (SL). A student may take only two SL exams at the end of the $11^{\text {th }}$ grade year that will count toward the diploma. Additional SL exams may be taken that year and declared as extra subjects.*Students will be eligible for the Bilingual IB Diploma by completing 2 languages selected from Group 1 with the award of 3 or higher in both OR by completing one Group 3 subject in a language other than English.
